Criminal Screening Check

From Winter season 2013, all umpires, coaches and volunteers are required to obtain a Criminal Screening Check via Netball SA Policies.

These screenings are paid for by Netball SA. Once the paperwork is completed it will get sent through to them for the screening to be processed and a letter will be sent to the applicant.

If you currently work in a position that a Criminal Screening is required and have one, providing the paperwork is still current, this can be used in place of issuing new screening paperwork, but we will need to sight a copy.

Uniform Reminder: Our uniform consists of the Club bodysuit (cost \$100), which must be worn at each game; a club Clash Top (also to be worn to each game and training if you wish.
