Criminal Screening Check

Currently, **all umpires, coaches and volunteers are required to obtain a Criminal Screening Check via Netball SA Policies.**

These screenings are paid for by Netball SA. Once the paperwork is completed it will get sent through to them for the screening to be processed and a letter will be sent to the applicant.

If you currently work in a position that a Criminal Screening is required and have one, providing the paperwork is still current, this can be used in place of issuing new screening paperwork, but we will need to sight a copy.
