We would like to ask that you give your coach plenty of notice if you are not able to attend training or able to play your game. A lot of preparation goes into preparing training sessions and games, and it makes it extremely hard if coaches have to change things at the last minute.

### Criminal Screening Check

From Winter season 2013, all umpires, coaches and volunteers are required to obtain a Criminal Screening Check via Netball SA Policies.

These screenings are paid for by Netball SA. Once the paperwork is completed it will get sent through to them for the screening to be processed and a letter will be sent to the applicant.

If you currently work in a position that a Criminal Screening is required and have one, providing the paperwork is still current, this can be used in place of issuing new screening paperwork, but we will need to sight a copy.

**Uniform Reminder:** Our uniform consists of the Club bodysuit (cost \$100), which must be worn at each game; a club Clash Top (also to be worn to each game and training if you wish. The clash top is a required piece of uniform as this is to be worn if there are two teams playing with similar colours (cost \$50).

Socks must be white (no logos) or the designated club logo socks which are available for \$10 a pair. Socks must cover the ankle bone to be suitable. Ankle jewellery is not permitted. Any jewellery (earrings etc.) must be removed before the game and nails need to be kept trimmed.
