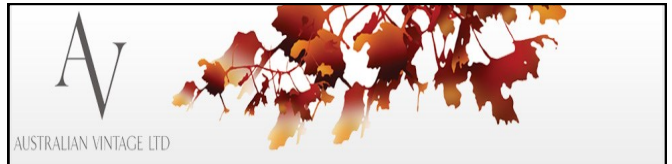

Netball—Codes of Conduct

Parents of young children (Net-Set-Catch, Sub Primary and Primary) girls should, if possible, remain at the courts during training in the event that your child has an injury, training finishes early due to the weather or any other unforeseen issues arise.

Due to the large numbers of teams using our courts and the congestion that arises, it would be appreciated if parents could wait for their child/children on the outside of the courts.

Coaches—remember that if you require help during your training, there is always someone available to be asked. Use your resources.

Remember rules are written to protect coaches, players and umpires, so these should be followed.

We updated our information booklet with the Club's Policy & Procedures; Player, Spectator and Coaches Codes of Conduct along with other information required through our association with SADNA and Netball SA, last year.
