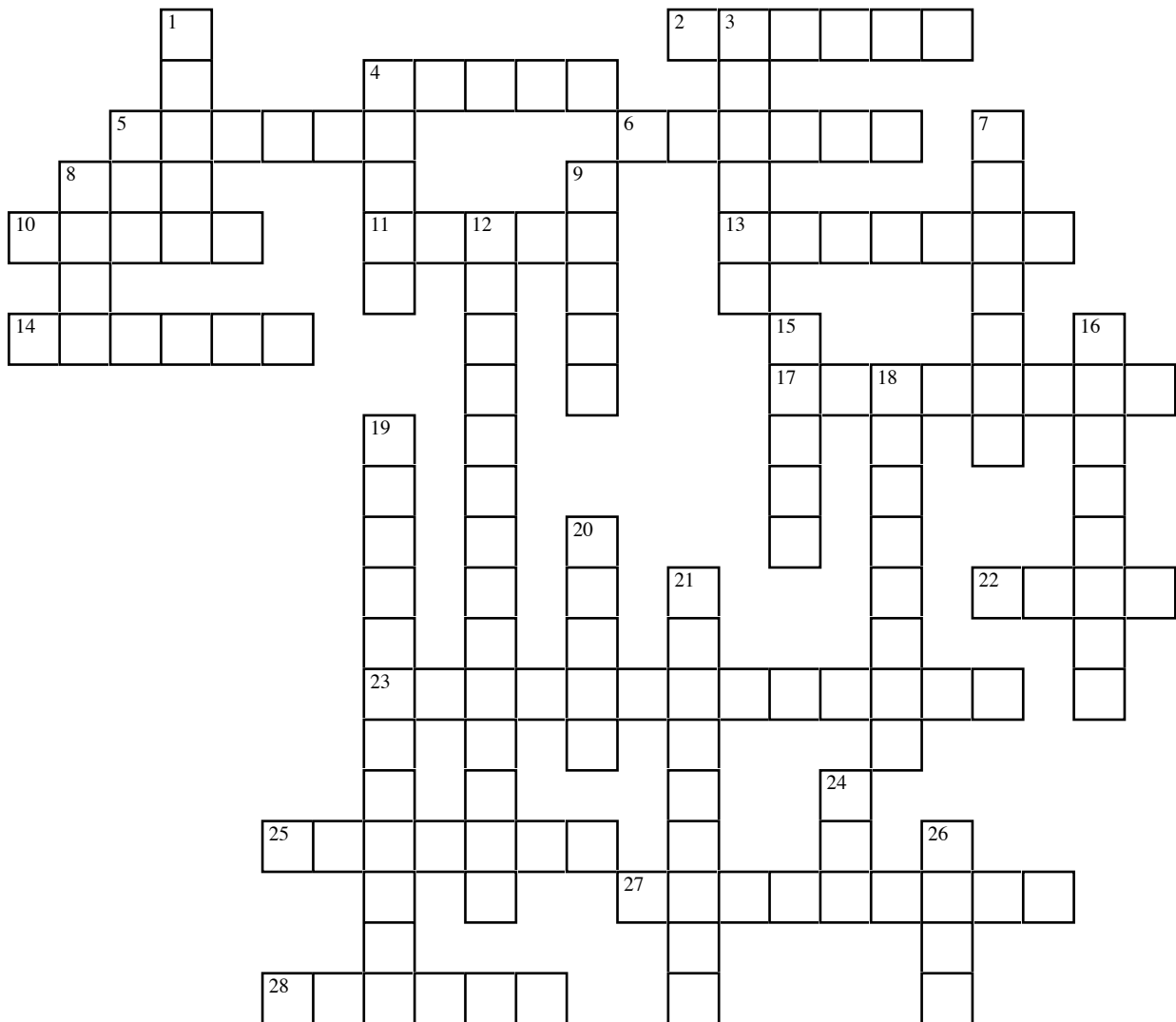


Crossword Puzzle

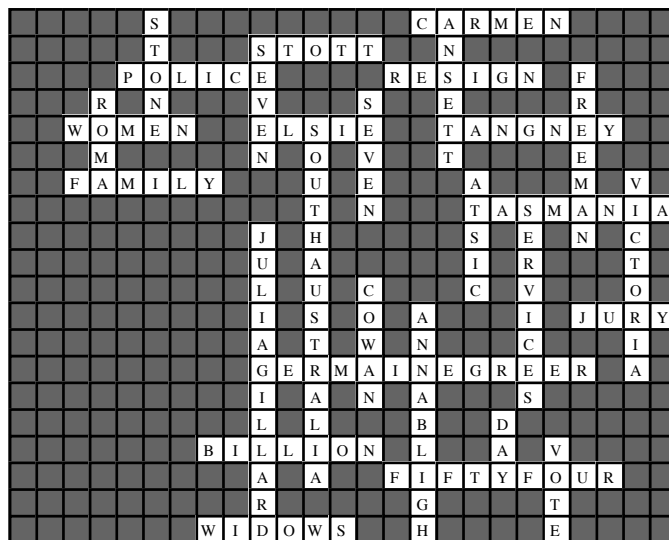
