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Description: This report is being generated by CSM Martin AIOLUPOTEA.

On Tuesday 3rd August 2010 at approximately 1720hrs a response was called over the radio by CSO Emily HARDY to attend Zone B s. 47F(1).

Upon arrival I did notice client known to me by the name of s. 47F(1) (1-2W6ZMS) laying on the floor outside his room s. 47F(1). I did notice there was trickles of blood on s. 47F(1) left wrist which I manage to find a bed sheet to wipe the blood from his wrist to identify how severe the client's wounds were.

I did request the assistance of CSO Drew BARTON and HARDY who administer first aid then cleaned and bandaged the client's wounds. Whilst this was occurring I did see three superficial cuts to client's s. 47F(1) wrist's, with minimal trickles of blood from left wrist noticed.

At approximately 1720hrs I did stand down the response and immediately notified SERCO on-call Scott LAMBERT regarding the current situation with client s. 47F(1)

At approximately 1741hrs on-call Triage Nurse later identified as Leanne LANCASTER was informed regarding client s. 47F(1) current situation. Leanne LANCASTER did advise M AIOLUPOTEA to step

up s. 47F(1) current SASH from 30/60 to Constant Observation and to transfer client s. 47F(1) to Zone C where the client can be monitored and cared for until seen by Medical Doctor or Nurse in the morning.

At approximately 1812hrs on-call DIAC is notified and updated regarding the current situation with client s. 47F(1)

At approximately 1817hrs client s. 47F(1) is being relocated to Zone C with the assistance of clients s. 47F(1) (1-3LDDWP) & s. 47F(1) (1-3LDYE) who a known to be friends to client s. 47F(1). Client s. 47F(1) was informed by M AIOLUPOTEA he has been relocated to Zone C room s. 47F(1) for his safety and welfare due to his more recent action's to self harm. Client was also advised he will be seen by Medical in the morning.
