Description: This incident report is created by ACSM Lesley BERG  
 On tuesday the 29th June 2010 whilst on route to Villawood IDC, Client **s. 47F(1)** 1-443H1Z  
 self harmed by head butting the side of the vehicle.  
 Client **s. 47F(1)** left arm was restrained by Diac Officer Aaron DE SILVA to prevent any further self harm  
 On arrival in the property airlock it was decided that due the clients non compliance and actual self  
 harm it would be better to hold the client in the compliance van until Operations Manager Chris  
 JACKSON arrived on the scene.  
 Operations Manager Chris JACKSON advised Diac officers that due to the actual self harm and  
 threats of further self harm, the client would be placed on constant sash and relocated to the  
 Annex in Blaxland Compound.  
 At 1955 hours, client **s. 47F(1)** and the Diac officers departed from the property department on route  
 to Annex at Blaxland.  
 This incident report will be updated as more information is made available.
