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Description: At approximately 0517hrs Tuesday 22nd June 2010, CSO Mitchell Farmer responded to an urgent request from Client **s. 47F(1)** to follow him. Mr. Farmer followed him to the southern walkway in South One Compound where he observed three Clients **s. 47F(1)** and **s. 47F(1)** supporting Client **s. 47F(1)** who had a sheet around his neck with the other end secured to an overhead beam. Mr Farmer called for assistance over the radio and, with the assistance of the three Clients released **s. 47F(1)** from the noose and carried him to a table in the Cabana. CSO's Viegas and Stuart arrived on the scene and assisted with administering First Aid to **s. 47F(1)** who was noted as breathing but not responsive. At 0522hrs and ambulance was called and arrived on site at 0537hrs. The ambulance, with **s. 47F(1)** and CSM Stacpoole departed the centre at 0608hrs, arriving at RDH at 0635hrs. NT Police also attended the site to gather evidence arriving at 0549hrs and departing at 0630hrs. When NT Police had completed their work, the area of the incident was reopened for Client use. The mood within the Compound was calm and compliant. **s. 47F(1)** has been involved in the Demonstration and Voluntary Starvation currently underway in South One Compound. A note indicating that he wanted to die was found at the scene. NT Police have the original of this note. As at approximately 0930hrs, reports from RDH indicate that **s. 47F(1)** was conscious and undergoing tests. He was quiet and compliant with hospital staff. This report will be updated as further information is available.
