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Description: At approximately 1645 hrs DIAC Case Manager Veronica Correa was addressing all clients involved in a starvation stage when for no apparent reason client s. 47F(1) walked out of the room and proceeded to the balcony of the upper floor of the accommodation block, and followed by LWB Meagan Spicer who witnessed the client jumping from the balcony at the same time M.Spicer called out for help. The call for help was responded by all staff present and at the same time an ambulance was called at 1700hrs. The client was lying on his back on the ground presenting no apparent injuries. The client was made as comfortable as it could be achieved by raising his head and feet ,covering the client with blankets and was reassured by the officers as well as the clients. At 1705hrs the ambulance services arrived and observed the client for vital signs, subsequently transporting the client to the Royal Melbourne Hospital at 1730hrs for assessment. The client returned from the Royal Melbourne Hospital at 1230AM 8 Jun 2010. He was subsequently placed on Constant Observation . During his stay in the Annex he presented no issues, kept his personal hygiene to an acceptable standards. Recieved many visits from his friends and was observed playing cards and watching television with them. However is spend most of his time sleeping On Friday the 11 June 2010 the client was seen by the pshycologist who deemed the client to be in no danger to himself any longer. Due to this assessment the client was removed from the Annex and Constant Observation. Subsequently s. 47F(1) was returned to his own room and placed on 60 minutes observation. At this point in time he has not presented any issues . This incident can now be considered closed.
