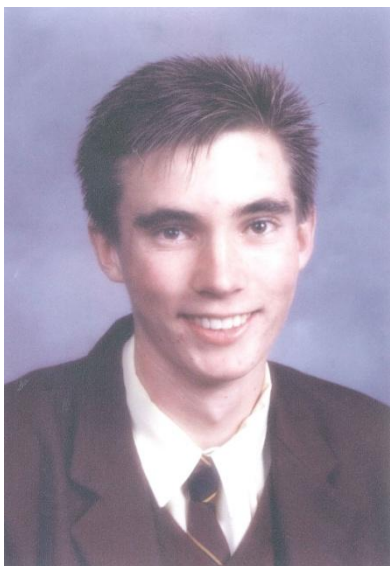

Dr. Matthew Richmond: Dominic College 1986 - 1991

Dr Matthew Richmond completed his Doctor of Philosophy (Chemistry) at the Australian National University in 1999, commencing his research in 1996. From 1992-1995, he attended the University of Tasmania and graduated with a Bachelor of Science (Honours). He received many prestigious awards for his achievements as an undergraduate: ICI Australia Limited Prize in Chemistry for the best third year student in Tasmania (1994); Royal Australian Chemical Institute Prize for High Distinction standard in Chemistry (1994), awarded to the most outstanding graduate in Chemistry in Tasmania; Dean's Honour Roll (1994); Professor Harry Bloom Memorial Award on graduating with First Class Honours and as the top Honours students for Chemistry in Tasmania (1995). In 2000-2001, he undertook post-doctoral research at the University of Ottawa in Canada. He has published many papers in the field of Chemistry, both nationally and internationally. He is currently employed as a Research Scientist at the Defence Science and Technology Organisation in Adelaide.
