

Michael Clarke: Savio College 1958 – 1961

Michael Clarke has had a distinguished career in the Public Service. From the Commonwealth Department of Health (1985-1989) he guided the community response to the HIV/AIDS epidemic and represented Australia on a UN mission to coordinate HIV/AIDS programs in South America and Central Africa (1992). As secretary of the Department of the Premier and Cabinet in Tasmania (1989-1992), he initiated radical changes, reducing over one hundred and fifty government/statutory bodies to eighteen Departments of State and reforming all public sector practises. As Deputy/Acting Secretary of the Commonwealth Department of Administrative Services (DAS) (1994-1997), he was involved in changes to the Australian honours and awards system and the privatisation of DAS-owned businesses. As a consultant (1997 -) he is developing better health systems in the Northern Territory and Western Australia, where TeleHealth is among his many achievements. Michael Clarke has also worked tirelessly for the church, unemployed and homeless youth, migrant communities and those affected by HIV/AIDS. He has served on many Boards and his contribution to community service is recognised nationally.
