Paul Curtain: Savio College 1967 – 1972

Paul Curtain has given exceptional voluntary service to Dominic College and the wider Hobart community. Since 1983, he has been an active member of the Dominic College Old Scholars' Association (DOSA). An inaugural member of the DOSA Cricket Club in 1973, he amassed 286 games (a club record) over 28 years. As a founder of the DOSA Football Club in 1976, he played 166 games and helped with administration until 1989. As principal founder of the Tolosa Youth and Community Centre (TYCC) (1992) and, shortly afterwards, the Tolosa Youth Advisory Service (TYAS) he has assisted disadvantaged youth in the community. Beyond DOSA, his contributions include administration of the Southern Tasmanian Cricket and Football Leagues; Chairman of the North Hobart Football Club; Cricket Coordinator and soccer coach for Dominic College. In 1993, he received an award from the World Confederation of Salesian Past Pupils of Don Bosco for his personal embodiment of the principles of Salesian schools. He was awarded an Australian Sports Medal for services to cricket in 2000.
