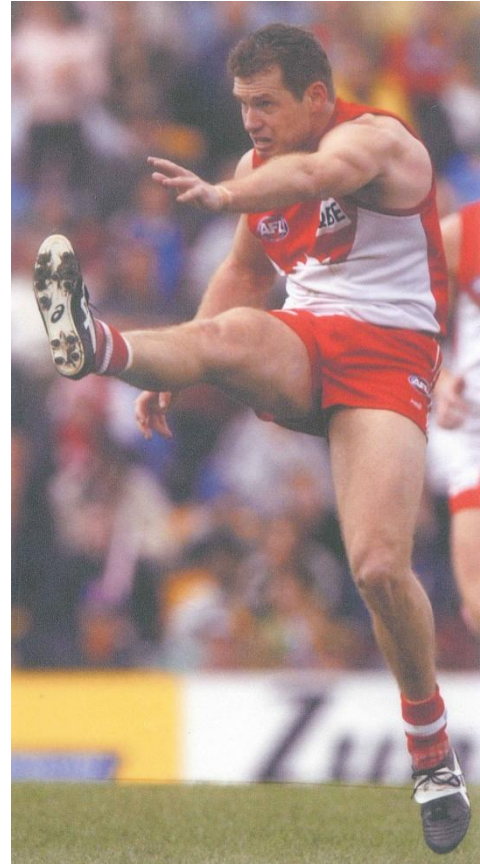

Paul Williams: Dominic College 1978 - 1989

In August 2003, Paul Williams reached 250 games of AFL Football: 189 games with Collingwood (Round One 1991-2000) and 61 games with the Sydney Swans (2001 -). He made his debut on the Tasmanian Football League Reserves in April 1989 and in the Seniors ten weeks later. He was Vice-Captain of the Teal Cup Team in 1989 and Captain in 1990, when he won the Michael Lark Memorial Medal for Best First Year Player Award in 1991; was Vice-Captain from 1995-1999; was second in the Copeland Trophy in 1995 (for Collingwood's Best and Fairest Player) and third in 1996, 1997 and 2000. He won the Best and Fairest Award at the Sydney Swans in 2001 and again in 2002, when he also won the Lou Richards Medal for AFL Player of the Year and was fifth in the Brownlow Medal. Paul was selected in the Australian Team this year.
