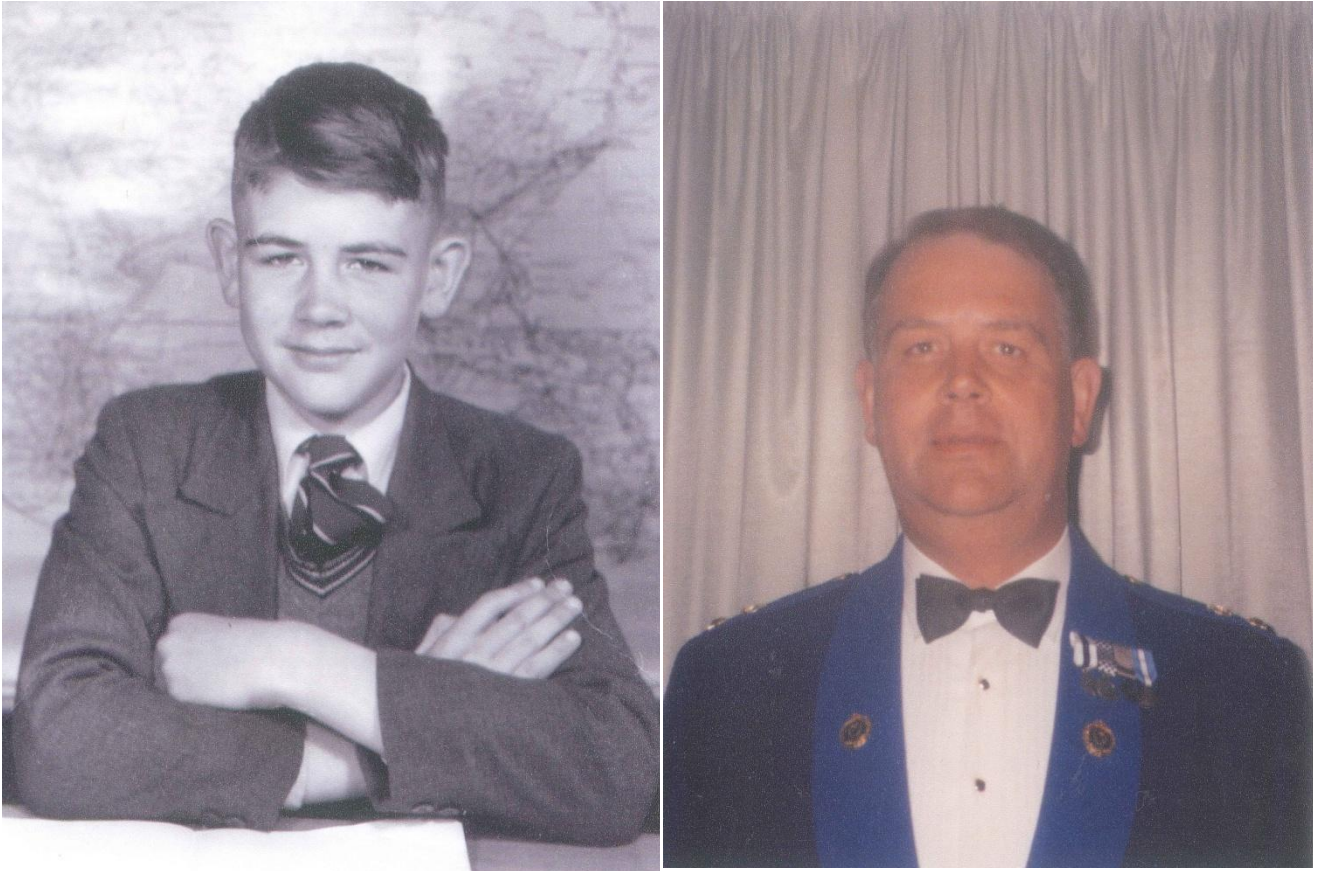

Robert Fielding: Savio College 1955 – 1964

In July 2005, with the rank of Commander of Southern District, Robert (Bob) Fielding retired after a distinguished career with the Tasmanian Police Service. In 1968, he was the youngest police officer to serve with the United Nations Peace Keeping Force in Cyprus, earning a United Nations Medal. He held many senior positions with the Police force over forty years, developing important policies and protocols to improve police practice and initiating many community projects aimed at reducing youth crime and assisting minority groups. As a Commander, he provided strategic and tactical command for major incidents and operations as diverse as the Port Arthur siege, street protests and blockades, the Olympic Torch Relay, rock concerts, United States ships' visits and State funerals. As Commander and Training Advisor for counter-terrorism from 1997 – 2002, he was responsible for the preparation and delivery of counter-terrorism training throughout Australia. His many commendations and awards include the Australian Police Medal.
