The teams will be travelling by bus to the Aquatic Centre on both occasions. For the STCPSSA Carnival the bus will leave school at 10.45am. At the JSSATIS carnival the bus will be leaving school at 8.40am sharp (STUDENTS NEED TO BE AT SCHOOL BY 8.20am). On the day could all students wear their bathers to school under their FULL SPORTS UNIFORM. Bathers **must** be College bathers or **plain black** (Strict Guidelines). Dominic College bathers can be purchased at the Uniform shop if required. Students will need to bring plenty to drink, plenty of food and some high energy snacks along with a towel and goggles (optional). The canteen at the Aquatic Centre **will not** be available to students.

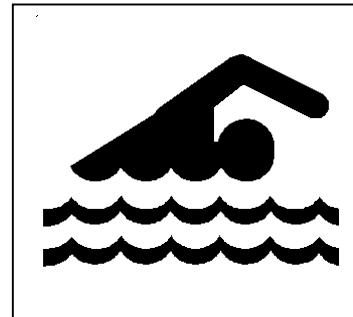
