Relay for Life 2015

Thank you for your commitment to the Dominic College Relay for Life team.

This has been a huge success. The expectation was to get 50 people involved at \$20 registration per person. This has been greatly exceeded, with 84 people signing up. This doesn't include over \$1,822.20 worth of donations.

We have currently raised over \$3,500.00.

Students have nominated various hours in which they can attend. I recommend that families and students reconsider these hours. It is an expectation that students **WILL** attend the Athletics Carnival on Monday (30th) following the Relay, therefore being tired is not an excuse.

On the day, Dominic College will have a designated area where a Dominic Tent will be located. A copy of this location will be distributed to students when confirmed with the Cancer Council.

When students arrive, they are required to **sign in at the Dominic Tent with a parent/guardian** and they need to ensure a Dominic staff member signs them in. Similarly, it is vital that a **parent/guardian comes to the Dominic Tent when they pick up their son/daughter up.**

What to Bring:

Being Tasmania, the forecast is ever changing. In saying that, it will definitely be cold overnight. Although we will not have a huge amount of space, a bag, with warm clothes is crucial.

We would like students to walk in their **PE Uniform on the Saturday afternoon**, then they can change into free **WARM** clothes from 8pm until the conclusion of the event.

The Dominic Tent will be lined with tarps to keep gear off the ground. We will also include some camping roll mats. Students may wish to bring sleeping bags if they wish to try and get some sleep, similarly, these can also be used for warmth when resting in the tent.

A rain jacket (school spray jacket will do) is compulsory, in case of terrible weather.
