Conditions

Students undertaking instrumental tuition must commit themselves to one full semester (2 terms) of tuition and fees. Once a student has committed himself to instrumental tuition, he must attend all his lessons during the billed semester. Lessons missed through student forgetfulness will not be made up or credited towards the next term and will be at the parent's expense. In the case of student illness or any other absence from school, prior notice must be received the day before the lesson by ringing the Music Department on 07 3813 9646, or emailing the relevant teacher directly, so that a make-up lesson can be planned. Failure to do this will result in the lesson being forfeited. Lessons missed through teacher absence will be made up at a mutually agreed time/day between the teacher and the student/parent or credited to the next term. ALL TUITION FEES ARE PAYABLE IN ADVANCE. Failure to settle music fee accounts will result in the cessation of lessons.

In most circumstances in the case of staff absence, instrumental teachers will email parents directly and make-up lessons will be organised.

If a student wishes to cease tuition at the end of a semester or for the following year, his parents must notify the Instrumental Coordinator (Mr Ian Feltham) in writing no less than 2 weeks before the end of that semester/year. Please note, students will be automatically re-enrolled for lessons in the following school year unless un-enrolled.
