EXPLICIT TEACHING




SUPPORTIVE COMMUNITY


VALUES-DRIVEN

VACATION CARE


We offer a robust program which allows your son to be cared for from 6.30am – 6pm during the school holidays (apart from a 2 week shutdown over Christmas).
