

Junior School Uniform Standards



General

- Each student is to be equipped with the regulation College uniform.
- Students are required to wear the correct uniform when travelling to and from Peace College each day.
- Uniform must be clean and ironed.
- The sports uniform must be worn when students are engaged in sport and Health & P E lessons.
- Regulation school bag is recommended for all students (available in 2 sizes)
- Hats are compulsory for all students.
- Students wear their wide brimmed sports hat when playing sport and when wearing the Sports Uniform. Students wear their formal hat when wearing their formal uniform.
- All P-5 students are permitted to wear the sports uniform to College on the days that they have sport and/or Health & P E classes.
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- All students must wear full formal uniform for School Photos. The date for School Photos will be advertised well in advance.
- A House coloured T-Shirt is required for Inter-house Swimming Carnival, Cross Country Carnival and Athletics Carnival.
- Should students be incorrectly or inappropriately attired, then the Head of Junior School will contact parents to negotiate either sending the student home to change or removing them from class until the matter is rectified.

Boys

- Boys are to wear their shirts buttoned up, and their socks, where appropriate, pulled up.
- Jewellery
A small Christian symbol on the shirt; watch; fine neck chain with a small cross; one signet ring; fine plain silver or gold bracelet; either chain or thin solid. No more than one plain stud in one ear lobe (an earring is not permitted). No other piercings allowed.
- Hairstyles
Must be modest and enhance the image of the wearer and the College.
Boys' hair must be off the collar and no extremes in styles will be tolerated. Dyeing or tinting of the colour of the hair is acceptable only if subdued and modest and of a natural tone. Hair can be cut no shorter than a No 2 cut. Fringes must not be below the eyebrows.
- Satin Boxer Underwear must not be visible.

Girls

- Jewellery - One small Christian symbol on the dress or blouse; watch; fine neck chain with a small cross; no more than a two set of plain sleepers or plain studs (limit of two in each ear lobe); one signet ring. Fine silver or gold bracelet; either chain or thin solid. No other piercings allowed.
- Hairstyles must be modest and enhance the image of the wearer and the College.
- Girls' hair must be tied back so that it is off the face and no extremes in styles will be tolerated. Dyeing or tinting of the colour of the hair is acceptable only if subdued and modest and of a natural tone.

- Fringes must not be below the eyebrows.
- Ribbons or scrunchies must be white, green, blue or "uniform check" only.
- Nail polish can be clear only.
- Make up is not permitted.
- Artificial nails are not permitted

Junior School Uniform

Preparatory (Prep)

Students may wear either the formal uniform as for Years 1-5 or the Sports Uniform.

Years 1-5

Boys

Shorts: Boys Navy Blue Elastic Waist Ruggers (no cargo pockets)
 Shirts: Sax blue shirt with College emblem on the pocket.
 Socks: Navy blue anklets (must cover ankles).
 Shoes: Black upper leather shoes. (No joggers) Preschool have the option of lace up or Velcro fasteners.
 Shoes are available from Williams the Shoemen.
 Hat: Navy blue style.
 Winter Jacket: Bonds navy blue V neck pullover or zip front jacket.

Years 1-5

Girls

Dress: Straight through Princess style, short sleeves, collar and zipper up front.
 Back pleat and small belt. Emblem on left side.
 Socks: White anklets (must cover ankle).
 Shoes: Black upper leather shoes. (No joggers)
 Preschool have the option of lace up or Velcro fasteners.
 Shoes are available from Williams the Shoeman.
 Hat: Navy blue style.
 Winter Jacket: Bonds navy blue V neck pullover or zip front jacket.
 Briefs (Optional): Fleece jacket

Plain Clothes days

- Students are to wear modest casuals if participating in Plain Clothes Days.
- Normal jewellery and make-up rules apply. Hats are still required when outside.
- Correct PE uniform is to be worn for PE classes.
- Safety footwear is to be worn for specified classes as required.
- Plain clothes must be consistent with the College values ie: clothing with slogans which are derogatory or offensive is not acceptable. This also applies to hats.
