

Senior School Uniform Standards



General

- Each student is to be equipped with the regulation College uniform.
- Students are required to wear the correct uniform when travelling to and from Peace College each day.
- Uniform must be clean and ironed.
- The sports uniform must be worn when students are engaged in sport and Health & P E lessons.
- Regulation school bag is recommended for all students (available in 2 sizes), if another bag is used it must be plain navy blue or black.
- Hats are compulsory for all students.
- Students wear their wide brimmed sports hat when playing sport and when wearing the Sports Uniform. Students wear their formal hat when wearing their formal uniform.
- Year 6-12 students can wear their sports uniform to the College on the days they have Sport.
- Year 6-12 students doing H.P.E as a specified subject must change into and out of their sports uniform during the day.
- All students must wear full formal uniform for School Photos. The date for School Photos will be advertised well in advance.
- A House coloured T-Shirt is required for Interhouse Swimming Carnival, Cross Country Carnival and Athletics Carnival.
- Tattoos must not be visible
- **Should students be incorrectly or inappropriately attired, then the Head of Senior School or Year Level Coordinator will contact parents to negotiate either sending the student home to change or removing them from class until the matter is rectified.**

Girls

- **Jewellery:** One small Christian symbol on the dress or blouse; watch; fine neck chain with a small cross; no more than two sets of plain sleepers or plain studs (limit of two in each ear lobe); one signet ring. Fine silver or gold bracelet; either chain or thin solid. No other piercings allowed.
- **Hairstyles:** Must be modest and enhance the image of the wearer and the College.
- **Girls' Hair** must be tied back so that it is off the face and no extremes in styles will be tolerated. Dyeing or tinting of the hair is acceptable only if subdued and modest and of a natural tone.
- **Fringes** must not be below the eyebrows.
- **Ribbons or scrunchies** must be white, green, blue or "uniform check" only.
- **Nail polish** can be clear only.
- **Make up** is not permitted.
- **Artificial nails** are not permitted.

Boys

- **Boys** are to wear their shirts tucked in and buttoned up, and their socks, where appropriate, pulled up.
- **Jewellery:** A small Christian symbol on the shirt; watch; fine neck chain with a small cross; one signet ring; fine plain silver or gold bracelet; either chain or thin solid. No more than one plain stud in one ear lobe (an earring is not permitted). No other piercings allowed.
- **Hairstyles:** Must be modest and enhance the image of the student and the College. **Boys' hair** must be off the collar and no extremes in styles will be tolerated. Dyeing or tinting of colour of the hair is acceptable only if subdued and modest and of a natural tone. Hair can be cut no shorter than a No 2 cut.
- Fringes must not be below the eyebrows.
- **Satin Boxer Underwear** must not be visible. It is recommended that they not be worn with shorts.

Years 10-12

Girls

Skirt:	Peace Lutheran College Seniors check fabric. With three pleats either side from the middle front and back. A deep pocket with zip, which also forms side zip. Mid calf length.
Blouse:	White poly-cotton, pointed collar forming a V-neck line. Embroidered College logo on pocket.
Tie:	Tie in the same fabric as the skirt tied in a regulation tie knot at the base of the v-neckline attached to each side of tie with buttons.
Socks:	White anklets (must cover ankles)
Shoes:	Black formal leather school shoes, with appropriate low level heel (black joggers are not permitted) Shoes are available from Williams the Shoeman.
Hat:	"Natasha" style Polypropylene navy hat.
Winter Jacket:	Peace Lutheran College Track Suit Jacket

Senior School Formal Uniform for Girls

The Formal Uniform for Formal Occasions when students are representing the College will consist of check skirt, white blouse, tie, navy jacket, black shoes and white socks.

Boys

Trousers:	Grey trousers
Shorts:	Navy shorts with longer leg with belt loops.
Belts:	Black leather bonded belt. Required to be worn with College formal trousers or shorts.
Shirt:	White shirt with navy College emblem embroidered on pocket, short sleeves.
Socks:	Navy blue long socks or anklets. (Navy blue long socks for formal wear to be worn pulled up.)
Shoes:	Black formal leather school shoes (black joggers not permitted) Shoes are available from Williams the Shoeman.
Tie:	Peace Lutheran College Tie - tied in a regulation tie knot
Hat:	"Safari" style Polypropylene navy hat.
Winter Jacket:	Peace Lutheran College Track Suit Jacket

Options

Terms 1 and 4:

Boys have the option of wearing Grey Trousers or Navy Shorts and Open Neck Shirt (No Tie).

Terms 2 and 3:

Boys have the option of wearing Grey Trousers or Navy Shorts and Open Neck Shirt (with a Tie)

Senior School Formal Uniform for Boys

The Formal Uniform for formal occasions when students are representing the College will consist of Grey Trousers, White Shirt, Tie, Navy Formal Coat, Black Shoes and Socks.

Facial Hair Policy

At Peace we expect that students will present themselves in a neat and well-groomed manner. From time to time boys growing into young men feel the need to express their masculinity by cultivating facial hair above their upper lip, on their chin and jaw line or a combination of the preceding.

Young men in their senior year (Year 12 only) are permitted to present themselves with facial hair provided it is in an advanced state of growth, clean, trimmed in length (no longer than 10mm) and shaped and/or styled to demonstrate a care and maintenance program.

Since we are very concerned about both the image of Peace, our corporate image, and the image of the individual students' potential employability status; the Principal and his/her delegates reserve the right to be judgmental as to the appropriateness of the facial hair style.

Students will not be able to go through the scruffy stage of developing the growth during term time. Therefore cultivation will need to take place during the holidays. Students not complying with the College Policy will be counselled to comply.

Male students not in Year 12 and under the age of 18 must be clean-shaven at all times.

Male students not in Year 12 and over the age of 18 will be treated as per the policy for Year 12 students.

If compliance is not met, then the matter will be dealt with in accordance with our inappropriate dress policy.

Plain Clothes days

- Students are to wear modest casuals if participating in Plain Clothes Days.
- Normal jewellery and make-up rules apply. Hats are still required when outside.
- Correct PE uniform is to be worn for PE classes.
- Safety footwear is to be worn for specified classes as required.
- Plain clothes must be consistent with the College values ie: clothing with slogans which are derogatory or offensive is not acceptable. This also applies to hats.

Senior Jerseys

The Senior Jersey is not part of the Official School Uniform. It may be worn by Year 12 students at school with their school uniform during Terms 2 and 3. It is not to be worn in public with the school uniform. The Jersey may be worn out of school with casual clothes.
