2019 School Fees

You would have recently received your Term 1 2019 School Fees via email. If these were not received please contact Sue Berntsson via bursar@plc.qld.edu.au

Peace Lutheran College Council has set 2019 school fees that can be viewed via the following link [fee schedule](#). Due to the timely payment of the majority of fees this past year, it has again allowed us to keep tuition and boarding fee increases to a low average of 2.2% for 2019.

Sibling discounts are as follows:

- Second Child – 20% off total tuition fees
- Third Child – 40% off total tuition fees
- Fourth and subsequent children – 60% off total tuition fees

Building Program:

Manual Arts Building & Hospitality Upgrade – construction has commenced on this project comprising a contemporary Manual Arts Complex and transformation of the current Home Economics area into a purpose built Hospitality facility. College Bus Service:

There is a 2% increase to bus fares in 2019. Cost for two or more children per family – \$2,220 per year or \$11.28 per day; and cost for one child – \$1,440 per year or \$7.38 per day. Due to the College bus service being full on most runs, we urge you to complete the [Transport Application Form](#) to avoid disappointment.

Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Program Years 7 to 12

3. Fees paid via Direct Debit either weekly, fortnightly or monthly, with full and final payment required by 30 November each year.
