## 2018 School Fees

The Peace Lutheran College Council has recently set 2018 school fees as per the following link [fee schedule](#). Due to the timely payment of the majority of fees this past year, it has allowed us to keep tuition and boarding fee increases to a low average of 2.2% for the coming year.

Sibling discounts remain as follows:

- Second Child – 20% off total tuition fees
- Third Child – 40% off total tuition fees
- Fourth and subsequent children – 60% off total tuition fees

## Building Program

**Peace Performing Arts Centre:** With completion in 2017, the Peace Performing Arts Centre is located adjacent to the Peace Centre. This innovative structure will accommodate music, drama and dance learning spaces, as well as music rehearsal rooms. ## College Bus Service

There will be a 2.5% increase to bus fares in 2018. Cost for two or more children per family – \$2,160 per year or \$11.07 per day; and cost for one child – \$1,420 per year or \$7.28 per day. Due to the College bus service being full on most runs, we urge you to complete the [Transport Application Form](#) by the due date to avoid disappointment.

1. Payment in full for the school year by 31 January 2018, receiving a 3.5% discount on tuition fees.
2. Fees paid by the first Friday of each term;
3. Fees paid via Direct Debit either weekly, fortnightly or monthly, with full and final payment required by 30 November each year. To set up a direct debit plan, please complete a [direct debit agreement form](#) and return to administration. If you have an existing direct debit plan with the College, you will be contacted in January to confirm the new instalment amount.
