Launched in 2015, The Gill Society formally recognises those who bequest a gift to the school in their Will.

It is named in honour of the School's first headmaster, Ernest Albert Gill, who was an extraordinary man with a pragmatic business sense developed in his original career as an accountant, and later as a passionate advocate for education.

## About the Foundation

The TACAPS Foundation was established in the late 1990s to address funding of the school's future development.

Its Board manages and distributes funds received for the provision of scholarships, the development of new buildings and the upgrade of existing facilities.

Examples of the strong history of giving at TACAPS can be seen, in particular, with the building projects of the last 15 to 20 years. These include the school's distinctive cloisters, the serene Chapel of St Aidan (pictured), the JH Fairfax Library, and the Millennium Centre.

One of the ways you can help the Foundation achieve its goals is by making a bequest to the school's Foundation in your Will. A bequest provides a lasting legacy that will benefit students for generations to come.



## Our school

More than a century ago, our school was founded with ample vision and the abundant goodwill of a supportive and giving community.

Known then as the Toowoomba Grammar School Preparatory School, its establishment was a bold and significant venture.

With the passing of 10 decades and multiple generations of students, Toowoomba Anglican College and Preparatory School (TACAPS) has emerged as a vibrant example of education at its best.

A strong belief in the school's spirit and purpose has provided exceptional educational opportunities for current and future students through generous philanthropic support.

## How to make a bequest

If you would like to make an unencumbered bequest the Foundation suggests the following wording, adjusted to mirror your wishes:

*I (insert name) give and bequeath to the Toowoomba Anglican College and Preparatory School Foundation Ltd of 2 Campbell Street Toowoomba Queensland 4350:*

*(one or more of the following):*

- *The rest and residue of my estate;*
- *..... percentage of my estate;*
- *The sum of \$.....; or*
- *My property, known as ..... (which may include real estate, art works, shares, units or other securities in listed companies or assets in your ownership at the time of your passing);*

*to be applied for the general purposes of the Foundation and in respect of such a bequest, I declare as follows:*

- *A general charitable intent shall apply,*
- *The receipt of an authorised officer of the Toowoomba Anglican College and Preparatory School Foundation shall be sufficient discharge to my executors and trustees, and*
- *My executors and trustees shall not be obliged to see nor enquire into the application of money or assets, the subject of such legacy.*

Alternatively, if you would rather that your contribution be directed to a specific purpose we invite you to contact the School and guidance can be provided as to the preferred wording to ensure that your wishes are carried out.

## Types of bequests

A bequest can be either named or made anonymously.

There are a number of ways to make a bequest to the Foundation to reflect your particular wishes. They are as follows:

- Residual (whole). The remainder of your estate after you have allocated any specific bequests.
- Residue (percentage). A percentage of the remainder of your estate.
- A specific dollar amount.
- Proceeds from the sale of certain assets such as shares and securities, or life insurance.
- Contingent bequest, should a loved one pre-decease you.
- A living bequest.

A bequest can be unencumbered or directed in support of a specific area of the school's operations, such as scholarships and building projects.

Unencumbered gifts give the Foundation the flexibility to direct funds to projects that the School Council and Head of School determine are in most need of assistance.

The TACAPS Foundation is deeply grateful to all supporters for their contributions, whether large or small.

Upon receipt, all bequests greater than \$2000 will be acknowledged on a board located at the heart of the school, unless the donor has chosen to remain anonymous.
