TIPS

Support for foster and kinship carers

To be eligible for TIPS you must have a child in your care accessing counselling through the ROSA program.

When to access TIPS?

Trauma Informed Placement Support can be accessed at any time in the counselling process and can be re-accessed when required.

Where a need is identified, discussion between Manager, Counsellor and TIPS workers will occur to determine your suitability for support.

How can TIPS help?

- Education about trauma
- Child regulation and behaviour management strategies
- Counselling support to explore a carer's own self-care, coping, and stress management

What is the cost?

There is no cost to you. It's free.

What we offer

- A free, confidential counselling service for children and young people, aged 4-18, who are in the care of or have an involvement with the Department of Children, Youth Justice and Multicultural Affairs
- Transition to independence for young people aged 18 - 21 years
- Education around trauma and subsequent behaviours available to Foster Carers
- Referrals must be made by the CSO
- Sessions occur weekly for about 1 hour

ROSA can work with children on:

- Angry outbursts
- Grief and Loss
- Family problems
- Emotional Expression
- Brain Development
- Trauma and Abuse
- Protective Behaviours
- Bullying





Our Program

ROSA is a therapeutic counselling program with a focus on working with children and young people to build on their strengths and create solutions to ensure their safety and emotional well-being. ROSA works to assist in the healing from the impact of abuse or neglect on children.

Accessing the Program

ROSA is a program of Centacare NQ and is one of a range of individual and family services. Access to ROSA is referral only by the young person's Child Safety Officer, and participation in the program is voluntary. Transport is available.

The counsellor

All counsellors have a tertiary qualification in the social sciences field.

Counsellors are ethically bound to refer clients to other appropriate services, i.e. for issues that are outside their field of expertise or where the issue does not fit within the guidelines of this program

Confidentiality

Counselling is confidential within the limits of legal and professional boundaries. This can be further clarified with your counsellor in the first session.

Outreach services

ROSA offers an outreach service that works with children and young people in Townsville, Burdekin, Ingham and Charters Towers.
