WHAT DOES A SCHOOL COUNSELLOR DO?

Why do we have a School Counsellor?

School Counsellors work with teachers, year advisers, careers advisers, the principal and senior teachers to assist students and their families and work to create safe, caring schools, free from violence and discrimination.

How are they different from teachers?

School Counsellors are trained, experienced professionals who also have a degree in psychology.

They work with students of all ages, and their families, from Prep to Year 12.

What might they do?

- Provide counselling for students
- Assist parents or carers to make informed decisions about their child's education
- · Assess students' learning and behaviour
- Assist schools to know how to best support students with a disability/mental illness
- Work with other agencies who are also working with students

How do students get to see a School Counsellor?

- Students may ask to see the school counsellor directly.
- A teacher, parent or carer, or a friend may suggest the student see a school counsellor or ask the school counsellor to talk to them.
- Students can ask their teachers how to see the school counsellor.

What students say to the school counsellor is confidential.

The counsellor will check with the student, parent or carer before passing on information to others.

Confidentiality will be maintained unless legal requirements require otherwise - for example, in accordance with child protection laws or if someone may suffer serious harm as a result of information being withheld.

Appointments with the school counsellor can be organised confidentially so that discretion is maintained. This reduces the chance of other students knowing about a student's involvement in counselling.
