### LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1993 SECTION 124

#### ORDER 27 – Object or matter in a public place

##### Criteria

Objects or matter must not obstruct or encroach upon a public place, or cause danger, annoyance or inconvenience to the public. Examples of objects or matter under this order may include, but is not limited to:



- (a) unauthorised site sheds and work caravans;
- (b) unauthorised structures on or over a public place;
- (c) unauthorised vehicles, materials and equipment;
- (d) unauthorised footpaths, crossings and driveways;
- (e) protruding tree or plant growth;
- (f) unauthorised signage;
- (g) gates that open outwards from a property;
- (h) garbage skips, unless approved; and
- (i) storage or accumulation of material, including waste.
