



PATROL RULES



1. Patrol Members are allowed a Maximum of fourteen (14) deficit rostered patrol hours throughout the entire season, In the event that a member is not available for a rostered patrol, the member MUST organize a substitute, failure to meet minimum patrol requirements may result in

- a. Penalty Patrols at the discretion of the Club Captain and Director of Lifesaving
- b. Exclusion of club sanctioned events
- c. Exclusion from carnival entry
- d. Exclusion from the use of the club equipment including the gym,
- e. Suspension of expulsion from the club with repeated abuse

2. A patrol member is expected to attend the patrol for the entirety of the rostered time. Should this not be possible the member is to advise the respective Patrol Captain prior to the commencement of the patrol and in a timely manner so that a suitable arrangement can be made to ensure the minimum patrol requirements are met.

3. A patrol member must not leave the beach without the consent of the Patrol Captain. Failure to comply with this rule WILL result in the Patrol Captain removing the member from the patrol log and a deficit patrol.

4. Patrol members must wear their full uniform, which includes a red and yellow patrol cap, patrol shirt, and patrol shorts. Failure to meet these requirements will result in the Patrol captain removing the respective member from the patrol log and a deficit patrol.

5. Patrol Captains are held responsible by the Director of Lifesaving and the Club Captain for the efficiency of their patrol and shall

- a. See the members become accustomed to the use of radio's
- b. Ensure that all members have done their annual proficiency before 31st December each year
- c. Completion of patrol log with the relevant information
- d. Control use of all lifesaving equipment

6. In case of extreme necessity, Patrol captains may make any decision regarding Lifesaving that the Club captain and Director of Lifesaving is empowered to make

7. Morning patrol is responsible for set up and signing on and off with surfcom Sydney

8. Afternoon patrol is responsible for take down, cleaning and shortage of all patrol equipment and signing on and off with surfcom Sydney
