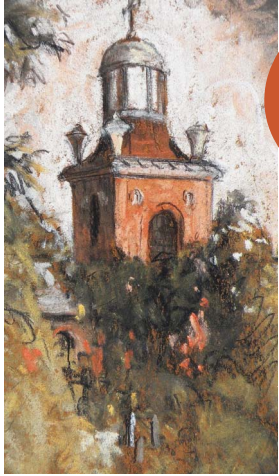

NATIONAL TRUST ST MATTHEW'S ANGLICAN CHURCH RESTORATION APPEAL

Independent of the 200th Big Birthday Bash, repair works on the tower and elsewhere in the Precinct are urgently needed. A separate public appeal has been launched by the National Trust of Australia (New South Wales) to raise over \$400,000 to forward the conservation of this much-loved historical landmark. The foundation stone was laid in October 1817 by Governor Lachlan Macquarie, and Samuel Marsden consecrated the church in 1822. St Matthew's is the oldest Anglican church by foundation stone in Australia.
