Group Booking Information & Terms & Conditions

Credit Card Details

For groups of 20+ or more guests credit card details are to be provided to secure the reservation. The card will not be charged upon booking. A \$10 per person cancellation fee will be charged to the card on file in the event of cancellation of the reservation within 24 hours of the booking time.

It is the organisers' responsibility to ensure the booking is up to date with final numbers in attendance at least 24 hour prior to the reservation.

For 'special' dates/events you may be required to purchase a ticket for entry or a fully prepay a package.

Special Dates/Events

NYE, Australia Day, Valentine's Day, Easter, Anzac Day, Mother's Day, Father's Day, Melbourne Cup, Christmas & local Festivals. Minimum five (5) days cancellation notice or deposit (ticketed/ set menu/ package) price is lost.

Prepayments for special events are non-refundable. If a booking is cancelled by you outside of the five day cancellation period, the prepayment will be issued as a gift voucher or may be used for an alternate booking date.

Platter Pre-Orders

For parties that wish to pre-order our platter menus for their reservations, we require a minimum of seven (7) days' notice. The platters are to be fully prepaid in advance at the time of ordering. Please notify us of particular special requests prior to your party date, including any cakes; a flat rate cakeage of \$22 applies for cakes brought into the venue. Please note as we operate and prepare food in a commercial kitchen we cannot provide any guarantees against allergic reactions to diners.

Beverage Service

You are welcome to set up a bar tab on the night or prepay for once in advance through our reservations team. All drinks are to be ordered over the bar, we do not have any bottle service. Wristbands can be provided for larger groups if needed, please advise us if you need them.

Children (Minors)

Please let us know if there are minors within your group. We are a fully licensed venue operating in accordance with the principles of Responsible Service of Alcohol Laws, which are Law in NSW.

Please note minors are not permitted to be in the venue past 5pm. The parent or legal guardian is responsible for ensuring that no alcohol is consumed by / bought for the minor and must be with them at all times. In accordance with liquor licensing law, the manager on duty is authorised to determine if a person is a responsible adult.

Seating Requests

We will do our utmost to seat/reserve your group in your requested area, however we are unable to guarantee this unless you have booked a private room (minimum spends apply). We have a range of areas and seating styles booths, low cocktail tables, share tables to high tops. Minimum spends apply to guarantee private function space/ & or roped off 'designated' areas.

Photo Proof of Age

Identification for proof of age and security screening will be required for entry. Patrons may be asked to show legal proof of age at any time. Acceptable forms of proof of age in NSW include; a current Australian passport or other country's passport · a current NSW, interstate or overseas driver or motor cycle driver licence (or interstate equivalent), NSW Photo Card. All primary forms of evidence of age must contain a photograph and date of birth. The Argyle will not accept any other forms of identification other than those listed above.
