



Kangaroo Island Bushfires - Visitor Safety Information

- The eastern end of Kangaroo Island is unaffected by fire and visitors are encouraged to stay in this area
- There are many emergency services personnel, vehicles and infrastructure repair crews working across the island
- Please respect the privacy of the local community that has been impacted by fire

Safety

- Roads have been damaged and conditions have changed. Road safety signage has been destroyed across much of the fire ground
- Visitors to the island must not enter roads that are not safe – for road closures see www.traffic.sa.gov.au
- Stay on sealed roads
- Road blocks are there for a reason, please do not drive around them
- To report unsafe driving call 131 444 or download the SA Police [Traffic Watch App](#)
- Trees may fall at any time. Do not park under burnt trees
- Do not walk into fire affected areas as the ground may not be stable
- Police are actively patrolling the area and will take action for instances of poor or unsafe driving

Drive to the conditions and reduce speed
