RECOMMENDED GEAR LIST

- Official Scout Uniform
including akubra, uniform shirt, uniform shorts, Scouts Australia belt, Australian Contingent scarf, gumnut woggle, official name badge, blue socks and comfortable walking boots
 - 1 sleeping bag (summer style)
 - 1 sleeping bag liner (inner sheet)
 - 1 inflatable pillow (or pillow case to stuff clothes inside)
 - 2 pair pyjamas
 - 2 extra pairs of shoes – a pair of water shoes (e.g. crocs) that can be worn to/from the showers and on water activities, and a pair of comfortable sneakers
 - 2 pairs of thick socks for day walks
 - 3 extra pairs of socks
 - 5 pairs of underwear
 - 5 handkerchiefs
 - 2 Contingent shirts
 - 3 casual shirts (must have sleeves and collars)
 - 3 pairs of camp shorts
 - 1 pair of long pants/jeans
 - 1 set of old clothes for muddy activities
 - 1 lightweight rain jacket
 - Toiletries bag – with soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, comb
 - 2 towels (quick drying preferable)
 - 1 swimwear
 - Passport
 - Torch and spare batteries
 - Personal first aid kit – including any medications
 - Insect repellent
 - Contingent sunscreen and hand sanitiser
 - Contingent drink bottle
 - Contingent contact cards
 - Home hospitality gift
 - Cutlery set (optional – as a back up to using chopsticks)
 - Short nylon rope for clothes line
 - A few large garbage bags

 - *Swap badges*
 - *Camera (and spare batteries)*
 - *Sunglasses*
 - *Watch*
 - *Coin purse or wallet*
 - *Jumper or jacket*
 - *Plastic coat hanger*

 - *Sewing kit*
 - *Shaving gear (if needed)*
