OVERVIEW:

Explore the highlights of South Australia's premier nature-based tourism destination, Kangaroo Island. Visit unique Seal Bay where you'll get up close to nature as the wild Australian sea lions frolic and laze about on the stunning beach. Enjoy lunch in an Australian bush setting, followed by a walk around Remarkable Rocks and Admirals Arch in the Flinders Chase National Park.

ITINERARY (Based on HTCC):

An early morning pick up from your hotel for a scenic coach journey to Cape Jervis taking in the picturesque Fleurieu Peninsula with its vineyards, coastal views and rolling hills. On arrival, board the Sealink ferry for the 45 minute crossing to Penneshaw on Kangaroo Island. Here you will board your luxury Sealink coach and your local driver/guide will take you on a tour of South Australia's premier nature-based tourism destination.

Visit **Seal Bay Conservation Park** where you will be taken on a beach walk with an experienced guide, and be amongst a colony of rare Australian sea lions. Get up close and see these wild creatures frolic and laze about – a truly amazing and unforgettable experience. Then enjoy a delicious **two course lunch** at **Vivonne Bay Bistro**, set in a beautiful Australian bushland setting, followed by a visit to the **Hanson Bay Wildlife Sanctuary**, where you will see koalas relaxing in the trees.

Spend the afternoon at **Flinders Chase National Park**, which is renowned as a sanctuary for native Australian animals including kangaroos, wallabies, koalas and echidnas. See the rugged coastline from walks around **Remarkable Rocks** and **Admirals Arch**. Remarkable Rocks provide great photographic opportunities, and the Admirals Arch boardwalk takes you down a rugged cliff face to reveal the spectacular rock archway, a natural nursery and safe haven for playful Long-nosed Fur Seals.

There is also a possibility that you will see more kangaroos and wallabies on your return to Penneshaw for your return journey to Adelaide.
