



QUILL CRAFT PROJECTS

Quill Paper Chain Snake



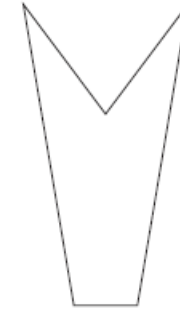
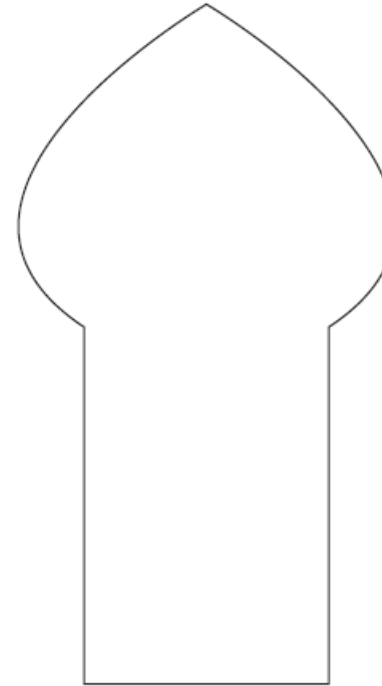
Materials:

- Quill Coloured Board
- Scissors
- Sticky Tape

Method:

1. Cut strips of coloured board.
2. Join two ends of a strip using sticky tape to make a cylinder.
3. Thread another strip through the middle and join the ends.
4. Repeat with strips to create a paper chain.
5. Cut out a snake head shape and thread it through one end.
6. Cut out details such as eyes and a tongue to stick onto the head.

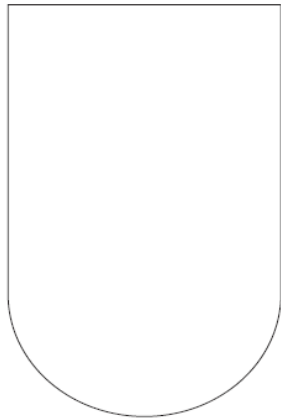
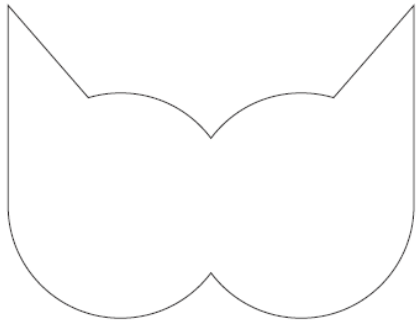
You've finished your paper snake!
Kids can get creative and draw different patterns and shapes on their snake.

Fringed Owl

Quill / Fringed Owl



Materials:

- Quill Coloured Board
- Scissors
- Sticky Tape

Method:

1. Cut strips of coloured board about 5cm wide.
2. Cut slits into one side of each strip to create a fringe.
3. Layer the strips onto a base card and attach with sticky tape.
4. Bend the base around like a cylinder and attach at the back.
5. Fluff up each fringe using fingers.
6. Cut out eyes, a beak, and a chest.
7. Attach them to the owls body.

You've finished your fringed owl!
Kids can get creative using different colours.

Quill / Paper Bee



Materials:

- Quill Yellow Board
- Quill Black and Yellow Paper
- Quill Vellum
- Black Marker
- Scissors
- Glue

Method:

1. Cut a teardrop shape for the bees body in yellow board.
2. Cut strips of yellow and black paper.
3. Cut slits into each strip to create a fringe.
4. Stick the black and yellow strips to the bees body to create stripes.
5. Cut out wings out of vellum and attach to the top of the body.
6. Draw on eyes and a mouth.

You've finished your paper bee!



Quill / Rainbow Paper Cloud



Materials:

- Quill Coloured Thick Paper
- Black Marker
- Scissors
- Sticky Tape

Method:

1. Cut strips of coloured thick paper.
2. Cut out a cloud shape out of white thick paper.
3. Stick colourful strips to the back of the cloud so they hang beneath.
4. Draw eyes and a mouth on the cloud.

You've finished your rainbow paper cloud!
