#### **Terms and Conditions MAAC Learn to Swim:**

- 1. **Payment of Fees:** FULL payment of fees is required at the time of enrolment. Booking is not confirmed until full payment is received. Payment can be made at MAAC by cash, cheque, credit card (Visa or MasterCard) or EFTPOS. Alternatively, credit card payments can be taken over the phone by calling 02 6752 2272.
- 2. **Preferences:** Students are placed into classes at the time of enrolment. Every possible attempt is made to accommodate your preference however this is not always possible. We do endeavour to accommodate as many requests as possible
- 3. **Refunds:** Once paid, program fees are non-refundable. Please consider all factors that may affect your enrolment. Refunds will only be issued for medical reasons (upon the provision of a medical certificate) or relocation (proof of relocation is required).
- 4. **Centre Entry Fees:** Program fees do not include entry, a discounted entry of \$3.00 per child for children 4 years and over is payable at Reception each lesson.
- 5. **Make**-up Lessons: I f a swimmer is unable to attend a scheduled class, refunds or credits will not be issued. We do not provide make up lessons for missed classes.
- 6. Swim Wear Policy: All students are required to wear appropriate swim wear whilst in lesson.
- 7. **Swim Pants:** All students under 4 years are required to wear Swim Pants whilst in the pool during and after the lesson. Swim Pants are provided with the \$1.50 entry at Reception.
- 8. **Media Policy:** Your child/children may be photographed for us in advertisement, instruction and/or media for publicity purposes. If you specifically DO NOT want you child to be photographed please let us know and confirm in writing.
- 9. **Supervision Policy:** It is a condition of entry into MAAC that all children under the age of 10 years must be accompanied by a parent/guardian (over the age of sixteen years) whilst at the Centre. Children under five years of age must be within arm's reach of a parent/guardian.
- 10. **Program Time:** It remains your responsibility to contact MAAC on 02 6752 2272 prior to commencement of the program to confirm your child's class details if you have not received email confirmation.
