The school works in partnership with the community to provide a Catholic education for an enrolment of around 100 students.

The education team is comprised of teachers, Aboriginal Teaching Assistants, Teacher Assistants and other support staff. The school has a Lasallian tradition based on the Lasallian values of: faith in the presence of God, concern for the poor and social justice, respect for all persons, inclusive community and quality education, and is associated with other Lasallian schools in Australia.

To achieve a quality Catholic education, the school, with the support of CEWA, has developed Religious Education, literacy, numeracy, social and emotional, physical education, health and nutrition, and vocational education programs that suit the learning context of our Indigenous students and implement the Australian Curriculum.
