2) WAHROONGA AND NEIGHBOURING COMMUNITIES


WHY DO PEOPLE COME TO WAHROONGA AND NEIGHBOURING COMMUNITIES?

a. There is a concentration of children and their parents





Implication for our mission:

b. More than 25% of our area's residents are born overseas. This number is growing






Implication for our mission:

There are many people living very close who are looking for community, connection, belonging and language development. We need to diversify our ministry to reach out to those who are not from an Aussie, English-speaking background.

c. There are many people in our area who have a strong affiliation with Christian churches.²



Implication for our mission:

We should not be ashamed of preaching the Gospel fearlessly because many people continue to identify as Christians. There are lots who view our church as their church, so we need to connect and build relationships with them. Easter and Christmas remain vital mission opportunities. We should also see the importance of *occasional* services (baptisms, weddings, funerals).

PRAY FOR MISSION IMPACT

In our mission field there are more than:

- 45,000 people in young families
- 10,000 young adults
- 18,000 seniors
- 31,000 people from NESB

By 2020 we are praying to be a church that has mission impact in all our ministries and at every stage and context of life throughout our area and globally through our mission partners.

> Pray for numerical Growth

We have seen God bring numerical growth over the past 2 years: from 85 adults to 160 adults and 70 children and youth each Sunday. We are praying that God will continue to grow the ministry of the gospel here, for the sake of His name.

4) FIRST STEPS: INITIAL PLANS IN 2016-2017

There are many areas of ministry that we will need to focus on in the coming years. Here are 5 focus areas where we plan to make significant *first steps* in 2016 and 2017.

1. CHILDREN AND YOUTH MINISTRY

Developments:

- Steady and significant growth in 2015 and 2016
- Our first Christmas Workshop
- The Stand (Friday Kid's Club Years 4 6)
- Restructuring Youth to reach younger years
- Experienced oversight of this ministry
- Growing teams in children & youth ministry

What's Next:

- Continued outreach to children (0-18) and families
- The appointment of a full-time children and youth minister in 2017

2. EVENING CHURCH

Developments:

• 2015: closing existing 6:30 congregation and beginning plans to plant in late 2016.

What's Next:

- Jan-April: meetings with potential partners
- May-July: monthly prayer and information meetings
- August: begin informal weekly gatherings

• October: public launch of new Evening Church

3. BIBLICAL AND PRACTICAL TRAINING FOR MINISTRY

Developments:

 Growing ministries has created a growing need for trained leaders across a range of ministries.

What's Next:

• Biblical and practical ministry training to equip people for ministry at St Andrew's, in our communities and beyond.

4. Church administration and infrastructure

Developments:

• The appointment of a full-time Church Administrator – significant improvement in our ministry capacities and support structures.

What's Next:

• Develop administrative support across the range of ministries needs and mission opportunities.

5. BUILDING RESOURCES

Developments:

 No significant work done on our church centre for 2 decades and increasing pressure on the functionality and capacity of our current premises.

What's Next:

 Parish Council to present a Capital Works priority list to the church family after Easter. Priority 1 will be a multi-faceted upgrade to aspects of the church centre costing approx. \$100,000.

5) RESPONDING TO THE WORK OF OUR VISION IN 2016




Support the work of the vision by giving financially In 2016...

In order to sustain our current ministry in 2016 and prepare for an appointment of a full time children's worker from 2017...we will need to:

- Increase our regular giving by \$35,000 (from last year's regular giving of \$325,952).
- This amounts to a 10% increase in giving from 2015 to 2016

This increase would enable us to meet our current ministry costs and get us most of the way to our next step of the full-time appointment in 2017.

In 2017...

2017 – we would only need to increase giving by a further \$7,500 (2%), because of the bequest, that could, if we needed it, help us again in 2018.

Each March we take time as a church family to hear about future plans, to pray, to review our own giving and make a clear commitment to regular giving for the year ahead.

- For some, after hearing of the plans before us, there will be an opportunity to increase your current giving.
- For some this review will result in a commitment to continue to give at the same level (and for some who are struggling it may be a decision to reduce their giving)
- For others there will be an opportunity to start giving regularly this year
