### Archbishop's Academic Requirements for Ordination Candidates who are Not University Graduates

**Requirements for Bachelor of Theology: this degree has 24 Units and 432 required points (each Unit 18 points). A full load is 8 Units a year (144 points)**

All students undertaking Tertiary Study for the first time are required to undertake an Elective Unit on Introductory Course on Reading, Writing, Research for Academic Purposes [e.g. University of Divinity's Study Skills for Theology (ARI009T)].
