





- support the Rector in the mission of the Church;
- assist each other (wardens, treasurer, secretaries) in the discharge of duties;
- act on all matters referred by Diocesan Council;
- complete annual returns;
- maintenance, repair and insurance of all properties;
- good stewardship of all collections, rents and other money;
- monthly remittance of stipend, salaries and entitlements;
- authorise and pay for all works and measures necessary for the welfare of the parish;
- handover of the custody of parish's funds and movable property to successors.





#### **OVERVIEW**



- Safe Ministry as a shared responsibility across all areas of the Diocese – it is everyone's responsibility to ensure our places are safe for all people to access, including children and young people.
- Everyone, including Diocesan leadership, clergy, parish councils, ministry leaders and the wider congregation, has a vital role to play in Safe Ministry.
- Keeping people safe is everybody's business!
- Ensuring processes and practices are in place to recruit, screen, train and supervise clergy and lay members is an important component of safe ministry.



#### POLICY FRAMEWORK



- Preventing Abuse
  - Child Protection policy
  - Checks and Training policy
  - Dealing with Persons of Concern policy
- Responding to Allegations and Incidents
  - Managing allegations policy
- Supporting Survivors of Sexual Abuse
  - Redress and Pastoral Care policy



#### **CHECKS AND TRAINING**



Checks – website has updated information for screening requirements

- ensuring all forms are completed accurately and returned to the Screenings Team
- including Working with Children and Police Clearances

Training – three new online training for all clergy, employees and volunteers:

- Safe Ministry Level 1 for those in positions without direct involvement with children
- Safe Ministry Level 2 for those in positions of leadership with direct and regular contact with children
- Refresher to be completed every three (3) years by those who have completed the Level 1 or Level 2 course as above (commencing in 2025)



#### REPORTING CONCERNS

Anglican Church Diocese of Perth



It is important that whenever you have concerns for anyone at church, be they a child or adult, you report raise these with your Rector or in Parish Council.

Parish Council have a vital role to play in ensuring practices are in place for responding and managing allegations and incidents

It is a legal requirement in Western Australia for doctors, nurses, midwives, teachers, police officers and boarding supervisors to report all reasonable beliefs of child sexual abuse to the Department of Communities - Child Protection and Family Support.

On 1 January 2009, the legislation that governs mandatory reporting of child sexual abuse became part of the *Children and Community Services Act 2004*.



Lodge a written mandatory report using the Department's secure <u>Mandatory Reporting Web System (MRWeb).</u>

This is a LIVE SITE. Do not use it as a training tool. You are about to lodge a report to Child Protection - Mandatory Reporting Service.

If you are concerned about your safety in making a mandatory report, please discuss this with your supervisor or manager and the Western Australia Police.


If you are concerned that a child is suffering abuse or neglect:

### SUPPORT FOR SURVIVORS (REDRESS)



We recognise that child abuse or sexual misconduct has a significant impact on a person's life and provide three avenues for survivors to seek redress:

- Anglican Diocese of Perth Pastoral Care and Assistance Scheme
- National Redress Scheme
- in some cases, civil litigation.









#### RECENT DEVELOPMENTS



- New WHS Act and Regulations came into effect 31 Mar 22
- In response to this:
  - Policy 2 WHS significantly expanded and improved
  - WHS resources on the Diocesan website significantly expanded and improved
  - WHS training introduced for all workers
  - Reporting to PDT and DC significantly expanded and improved
- Changes coming:
  - Policy 2 WHS amendments around Psychosocial Hazards
  - New Policy 2.1 Respect at Work
  - New Policy 2.2 Grievances and Complaints



#### **TRAINING**



- The WHS Act requires that training is provided to all workers.
- Link to course sent to all New Parish Office Bearers and Councillors
- As of 8 Sep, 46 out of 192 (24%) have completed the course

#### **OUR RESPONSIBILITY AS INDIVIDUALS**





- take reasonable care of our own health and safety;
- ensure the health and safety of others in the workplace;
- follow health and safety instructions;
- provide suggestions on how to improve health and safety;
   and,
- report all incidents and hazards.

#### PARISH COUNCIL RESPONSIBILITIES



- Work health and safety should be a standing item at every parish council meeting to:
  - consider new or unresolved incident and hazard reports;
  - discuss internal inspections or activity checklists;
  - consider external inspections and assessments;
  - assess first aid requirements and procedures;
  - assess fire and emergency response procedures; and,
  - make decisions about health and safety improvements or controls to minimise risk.



- Pre-employment checks must be coordinated though HR
- Employment contract must be completed and approved by HR / Diocesan Secretary

- Termination must be completed and approved by HR / Diocesan Secretary
