

Ground Level Particulate Notification Report - 07 June, 2020

Adelaide Brighton Cement, Birkenhead Works
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EPA Licence No: 1126

Summary

The 24-hour average particulate matter monitoring data collected at the Community Park and Gunn Street monitoring sites during 07 June, 2020 is shown in [Table 1](#) below. The data indicates that:

- The 24-hour average PM_{2.5} concentration measured at Community Park of 26.2 µg/m³ exceeded the EPP Air criterion of 25 µg/m³

The 24-hour average PM_{2.5} concentration measured at Community Park of 26.2 µg/m³ exceeded the EPP Air criterion of 25.0 µg/m³. All ABC monitors (on site and off site), showed similar particulate levels and trends. This indicates the particulate level was from a localised airshed condition, rather than related to any specific site activity. Elevated levels of particulate in the early hours of the morning dropped during the day before starting to rise early in the evening to elevated levels. PM_{2.5} is commonly produced from combustion sources. Given the low wind speeds, reduced air shed flushing, the PM_{2.5} particulate levels and trends are indicative of the increased use of domestic wood heaters at this time of the year. Unfortunately EPA monitoring data was unavailable at the time of preparing this report

Community Monitoring

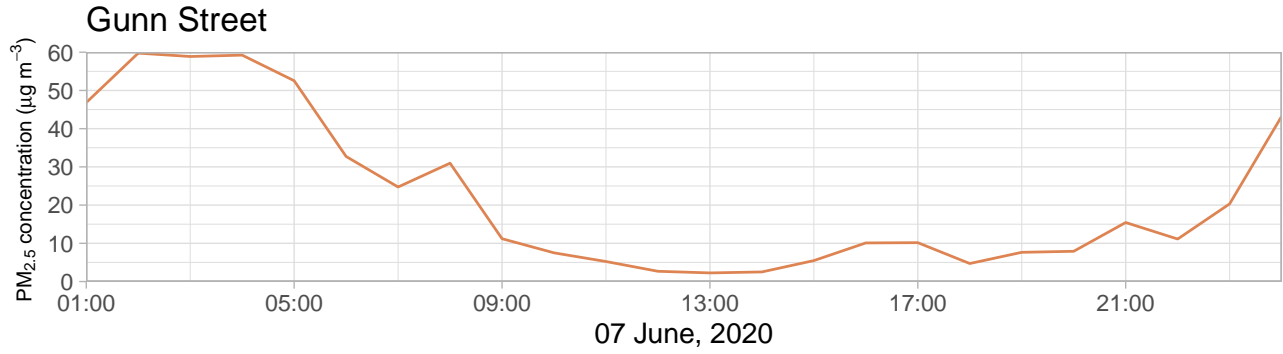
Monitoring data collected at the community monitoring sites is presented in this section.

The table below shows the proportion of PM₁₀ and PM_{2.5} measured at each monitor, according to the average wind direction at the time of monitoring.

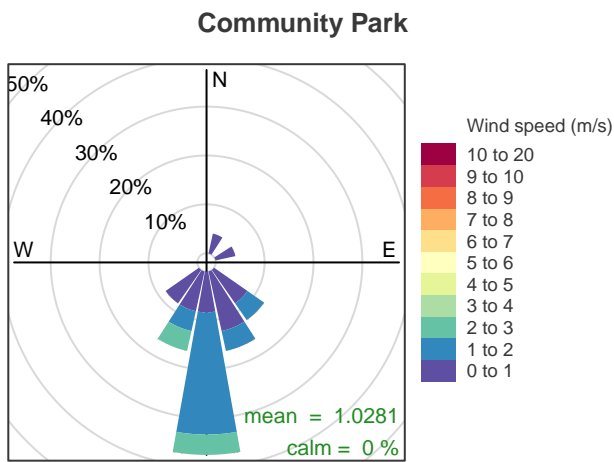

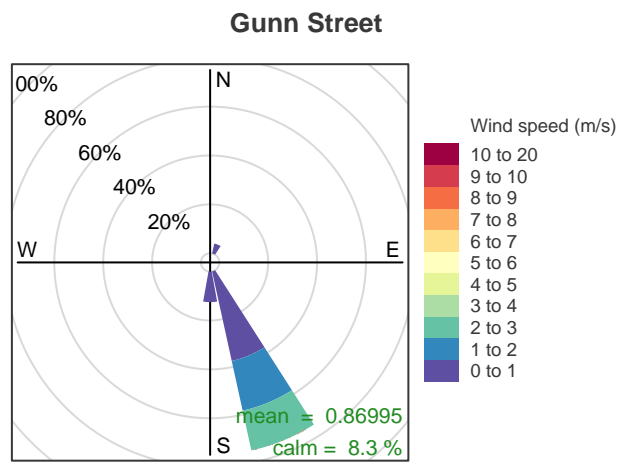




The figures below show wind roses summarising the period 07 June, 2020.



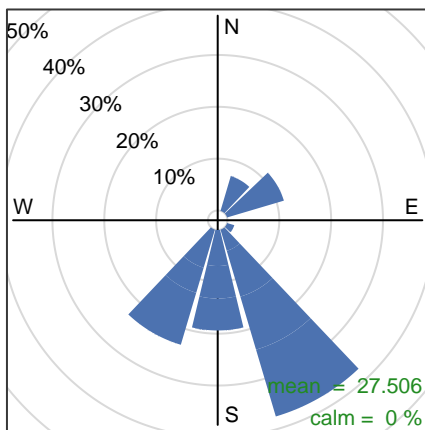
Frequency of counts by wind direction (%)



Frequency of counts by wind direction (%)

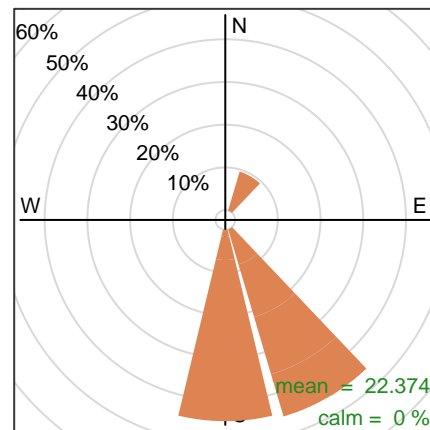
The figures below show dust roses summarising the period 07 June, 2020
