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### OVERVIEW OF DIOCESAN EVENTS AND TRAINING

The purpose of this note is to highlight upcoming Diocesan events and training for planning purposes. Each of these events can be viewed on the Diocesan website [here](#).

- **New Diocesan Statutes - Consultation with Laity - 8.30am Saturday 5 September - Wollaston Conference Centre.** The Legislation Committee of Diocesan Council have been busy preparing revised Professional Standards, Clergy Discipline and Clergy Appointments and Licensing Statutes. The purpose of this session is to seek feedback on these statutes from laity. An email will be sent nearer the time with links to the draft documents.
- **New Diocesan Statutes - Consultation with Laity and Clergy - 8.30am Saturday 3 October - Wollaston Conference Centre.** The Legislation Committee of Diocesan Council have been busy preparing revised Professional Standards, Clergy Discipline and Clergy Appointments and Licensing Statutes. The purpose of this session is to seek feedback on these statutes from clergy and laity. An email will be sent nearer the time with links to the draft documents.
- **Rural Parish Office Bearers' Training - 9.00am Saturday 17 October - Holy Trinity, York.** The purpose of this session is to provide easier access to this training for our rural parishes, who might find it difficult to attend similar sessions held at Wollaston Conference Centre.
- **Parish Office Bearers' Training - 8.30am Saturday 28 November - Wollaston Conference Centre.** The program for this session will be advised nearer the time, although there will be a focus on where to find information on the new Diocesan website. The Diocesan Office will aim to promulgate reminder emails approximately three weeks out from each event and, if necessary, provide links to documents relevant to the meeting.

ChurchSafe training sessions can also be viewed on the Diocesan website. All volunteers and paid employees who are actively involved in Children's Ministry and activities and all those in Anglican leadership roles must complete an initial ChurchSafe training workshop and then attend a refresher session every three years. While the Diocese recognises there are many community

programs available, all church workers must attend training that is facilitated and accredited by the Diocese in keeping with the Safe Ministry to Children's Canon.

It is compulsory for all licensed Clergy to attend a ChurchSafe session within six (6) months of being appointed to a position in the Diocese and attend a Professional Standards Clergy PD Day every three years. All those who hold a PTO are also required to attend a PD day every three years.

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## THE WOLLASTON CERTIFICATE IN THEOLOGY - TERM 3 OFFERINGS 2020

With restrictions lifting in WA, we are excited to offer the below units internally this term.

### **Core Unit - Introduction to Christian Doctrine**

This unit, taught by the Warden of Wollaston Theological College, the Reverend Dr Gregory Seach, introduces some of the major themes and disciplines of Christian theology through a focus on Jesus Christ. The historical figure of Jesus Christ stands at the centre of Christian faith, Christian practice, and Christian teaching. This unit focuses on the person and work of Jesus Christ and introduces some of the central concerns of Christian theology.

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## **ANGLICAN SCHOOLS COMMISSION - CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER**

Since 1985 the Anglican Schools Commission (ASC) has had as its core purpose to "establish, acquire and support low-fee Anglican systemic schools which provide a high-quality, inclusive, caring Christian education". On any measure, the ASC has been incredibly successful in delivering on its original vision. Today the ASC includes 14 schools, 11 in WA, two in VIC and one in NSW. The ASC also has an international student's division and an English Language School based in the Perth CBD. The position of Chief Operating Officer (COO) is a newly established role reporting to the CEO and will be a key member of the executive leadership team. The COO is responsible for operationalising the ASC's strategy as articulated in the Strategic Plan 2021. In particular this will include:

- Optimise the ASC's operating capabilities and ensure best practice in stakeholder engagement. Maintain a spirit of service.
- Management of policy and procedures relevant to ASC-wide functions; including risk and compliance, technology, communications, teaching and learning, and project management of new schools.
- Collaborating with the executive on matters relating to operational planning and organisational performance.

Intending applicants are expected to offer 5+ years' experience in an executive leadership role with similar 'Head of Operations' type responsibilities. This should include experience in policy, strategy, risk and compliance/regulation, technology and communications management. High level and relevant tertiary qualifications are essential.
