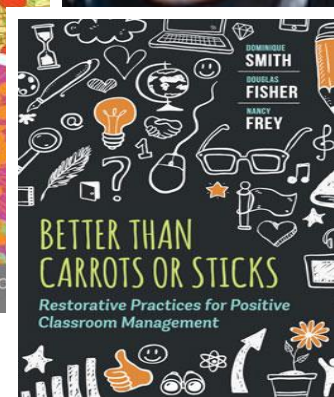
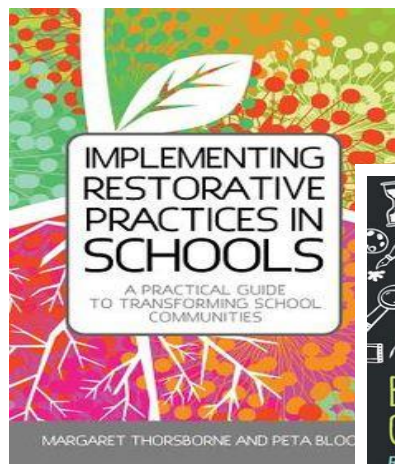
## EVENT OVERVIEW
