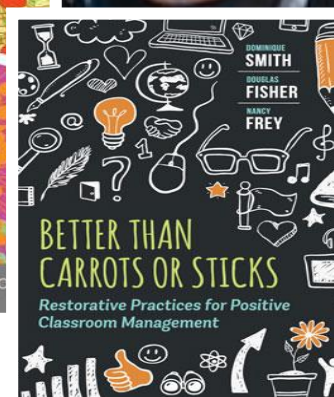
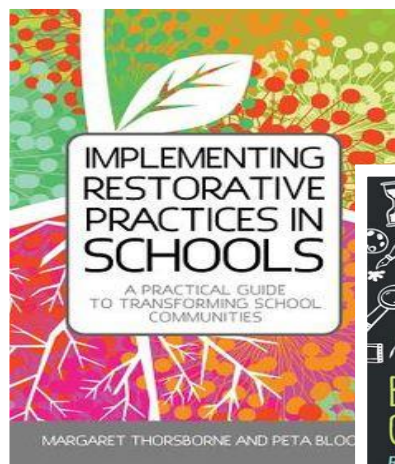
EVENT OVERVIEW
