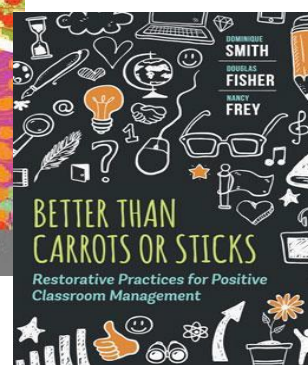
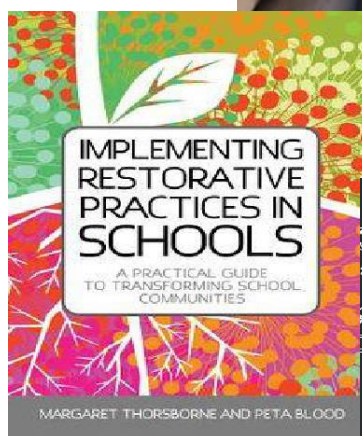
EVENT OVERVIEW
