Abstract Formatting Instructions

- Manuscripts should be submitted in Word format (docx, doc).
- Title should be short and explicit.
- Maximum of 350 words.
- Use a simple font (e.g., 10-point Arial) for text.
- Headings should be **bold** and 14 point and small case letters.
- Do **not** use field functions.
- Please turn **off** your track changes.
- Do not use justified text alignment.
- Use tab stops or other commands for indents, not the space bar.

- *Authors in Italics*. Please underline the presenting author.
- Please include affiliations for all authors after the author list and put in *italics*.
- Please indicate the name of the corresponding author by an asterisk*.
- The Email of the corresponding author should be included below the affiliations.

- *If appropriate, use the following headings: Introduction, Methods, Results and Discussion*
- *Use italics for emphasis*.
- Abbreviations should be defined at first mention and used consistently thereafter.
- Please always use internationally accepted signs and symbols for units, SI units.
- URLs of all databases referenced should be included.
- Nomenclature for variants must follow HGVS guidelines <http://www.HGVS.org/varnomen>
- Nomenclature for genes must follow HGNC guidelines <http://www.genenames.org/>
