



National Thunder Motorcycle Rally Raffle Terms and Conditions

The Promoter is Tamworth Regional Council (ABN: 52 631 074 450), 437 Peel St, Tamworth NSW 2340.

1. Information on how to enter the Promotion and a description of the prizes that may be won in the Promotion form part of these Terms and Conditions of Entry. Participation in the Promotion constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions of Entry. Entries not complying with these Terms and Conditions of Entry are ineligible and the Promoter reserves its absolute right to disqualify any entrant from the Promotion if any entries do not comply with these Terms and Conditions of Entry.
2. Subject to these Terms and Conditions of Entry, entry is open to all Australian residents over the age of 18. Minimum age is 18.
3. Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter, their related companies, contractors and agencies directly associated with this Promotion are ineligible to enter. Entrants can only enter in their own name.
4. The Promotion opens at 6pm on the 20th day of December 2019 and closes at 12pm on the 3rd day of October 2021 (AEST), unless sold out prior.
5. The winners will be drawn on the evening of the 3rd Day of October 2021 and notified via phone and email. Winners will be listed in the Northern Daily Newspaper on Saturday 9 October 2021 and will be posted on social media.
6. There will be a maximum of 5,000 entries in the Promotion
7. There are eight individual prizes to be won:

 - 7.1.1. H-D® Forty-Eight® valued at \$18,995 ride away (including GST) RRP
 - 7.1.2. Triumph T120 valued at \$19,990 ride away (including GST) RRP
 - 7.1.3. Ducati SuperSport valued at \$18,000 ride away (including GST) RRP
 - 7.1.4. Honda CB1000R valued at \$19,660 ride away (including GST) RRP
 - 7.1.5. Suzuki Katana valued at \$18,990 ride away (including GST) RRP
 - 7.1.6. Yamaha MT-09TR valued at \$17,650 ride away (including GST) RRPPlus additional accessories and/or merchandise from Western Ranges Motorcycles to bring the total First Prize value to \$20,000 including GST. The value of accessories and/or merchandise to equal the difference between \$20,000 (inc GST) and the price of the selected motorbike listed above. The value of each model listed above is subject to change and specific model listed above may be discontinued prior to the prize draw in October 2021.

 - 7.4. Five consolation prizes of double registrations to the 2022 National Thunder Motorcycle Rally.
8. The motorcycles listed as part of the First Prize are the base model with standard paint and equipment only. The prize motorcycle will be subject to availability at the time of redemption, if the

model represented in the raffle is not available for any reason the winner may select another motorcycle to the ride away value of \$20,000 in total. The prize motorcycle remains at the discretion of Western Ranges Motorcycles at all times.

9. The First Prize ride away pricing includes registration and CTP. The winner is responsible for their own comprehensive insurance. The Promoter and Western Ranges Motorcycles shall not be liable for any loss, damage or personal injury in connection with accepting or using the prize and it is the operators' responsibility to obtain/hold relevant license for the motorcycle.
10. The First Prize winner is responsible for transportation and delivery of the First Prize Motorcycle.
11. The First Prizes come with terms and conditions as determined by Western Ranges Motorcycles. The Promoter is not liable for any difficulties or issues faced dealing with Western Ranges Motorcycles.
12. The Second and Third Prizes come with terms and conditions as determined by Chris Watson Travel, travel agent. The Promoter is not liable for any difficulties or issues faced dealing with the travel agency
13. It is the Third Prize winner's responsibility to ensure they make use of the Chris Watson travel voucher before it expires.
14. Each winner is responsible for any applicable taxes and fees including state and federal sales or income tax where applicable.
15. Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be taken as cash.
16. Prize values are based upon the recommended retail prices at the time of printing (inclusive of GST). The Promoter accepts no responsibility for change in prize value between now and the ultimate prize redemption date.
17. Each individual registering to attend the National Thunder Motorcycle Rally and paying the full rally registration fee will receive one (1) complimentary entry into the Promotion. If the registration is cancelled and a full or part refund is made (in accordance with the National Thunder Motorcycle Rally Terms and Conditions of Purchase) the single complimentary entry in the Promotion will be withdrawn.
18. Additional tickets can be purchased for \$50 (including GST) each. Tickets can be purchased either on line when registering to attend the rally or in person at AELEC during the National Thunder Motorcycle Rally event.
19. By registering for the National Thunder Motorcycle Rally you are deemed to have accepted the Terms and Conditions of the promotion.
20. The Promoter reserves the right to request winners to provide proof of identity, proof of Australian residency status at the nominated prize delivery address and/or proof of entry validity, in order to claim a prize. Acceptance of proof of identification, Australian residency status and entry considered suitable for verification is at the discretion of the Promoter. In the event that a winner cannot provide proof, the winner will forfeit the prize in whole and no substitute will be offered.
21. The raffle prizes will be drawn on the Thunder Stage on the evening of Sunday 3 October 2021 at the National Thunder Motorcycle Rally.
22. Incomplete, ineligible or incomprehensible entries will not be accepted. Entrants who provides incorrect, misleading or fraudulent information are ineligible to participate in the promotion and all entries of an entrant who is deemed by the promoter to have provided incorrect, misleading or fraudulent information may, at the discretion of the promoter, be deemed invalid.
23. The Promoter reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and reserves the right to disqualify any entrant for tampering with the entry process or for submitting an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions of Entry.
24. The winner will be notified via phone and email and will have 10 working days to get in touch and redeem their prize. The Promoter will not be held responsible in the event that prize winner cannot travel to Tamworth within the time required for prize redemption. If the winner has not made contact within 10 business days another winner will be chosen.
25. The Prize must be taken as offered and is not exchangeable, transferable or redeemable for cash or for resale. If for whatever reason the specified prize is unavailable, the Promoter reserves the right to award an alternate prize of equal or greater value.
26. If this Promotion is not capable of running as planned for any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter (including infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized

intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoter which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this Promotion), the Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process, and to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Promotion, subject to any written directions made under State or Territory legislation.

27. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any tax implications that may arise from winning of the Prizes. Independent financial advice should be sought.
28. No prohibited prizes will be given away
29. The Prize must be taken as stated and no compensation will be payable if a winner is unable to use a Prize as stated.

The Promoter may use any personal information that an entrant has provided to it as part of the Promotion for the purpose of running the Promotion, and also in advertisements, publications, media statements and other promotional material associated with the Promotion. For purposes of public statements and advertisements the Promoter will only publish the winner's first name and surname. To the extent permitted by law, each entrant and each Prize winner irrevocably waives all rights against the Promoter and its related companies, its employees, servants, agents, independent contractors or representatives (together, the 'Indemnified Persons') and releases and discharges the Indemnified Persons from all claims, liability, costs, expenses, damages or losses (whether direct, indirect or consequential and whether arising under statute, from negligence, personal injury, death, property damage or otherwise) arising from, or in connection with the Promotion or a Prize. These terms do not limit or exclude liability to the extent that liability cannot, by law, be limited or excluded.
