What you can expect from daytime 3-hour online course...

Close the Door and Draw

10 – 10.15am – class starts and show and tell

10 .15am – class briefed on weekly project, supported by email sent prior to class

10. 20/25 – 11.30am – start class - one on one feedback

11.30 – 15 min break – unmute everyone for online connecting

11. 45 – resume class - one on one feedback

12. 50 –open unmute discussion and prep ideas for coming week.

WhatsApp

During class – WhatsApp available for tutor feedback.

After class – WhatsApp is for group sharing of weekly artwork, not tutoring.

Class Emails

Each week before class, you will be sent a class email outlining weekly projects. This will help you prepare for online class, offer direction and inspiration, connected to weekly drawing activity.

Show and tell

Show and Tell is to help develop online connections and friendships by getting to know each other a little better.

It is for online participants to show and talk about an artwork they have made, it doesn't have to be a drawing. It can be new artwork, old or project you are currently working on. It can even be an artist you admire if you don't want to talk about a work of your own.

Ideas to help you know what to talk about are...why you picked that work, what is it about that work you like or dislike. Is there a story behind the work and how are you making it?

15 min break

Unmute class for online chatting and connecting.

How much time you can expect during online class.

The aim is to see each student twice during 3-hour session. This is to check in on how work is going, ask questions, get feedback and direction. The length of the time you get in these one on one sessions will depend on the class size.

*Optional - You may prefer longer feedback session instead of two smaller ones.

*During online feedback sessions with other students you will hear artistic directions others are taking and the advice given to help them achieve this, hearing this is often helpful to you and similar to hearing advice given to others in a classroom atmosphere.
