### What you will need

**Make sure you have the following before your workshops starts:**

- Paper - minimum size A3 as this will be a large scale drawing. Scale will depend on your paper and space.
- Graphite pencil
- Eraser
- Sharpener

**About this workshop:**

- Learn step by step the process of drawing a large realistic eye - make it pop!
- Study the eye close up and see how the different elements go together
- Be shown techniques to create a sparkle or reflection in your eye



### Techno bits

**Be sure to test your set up first:**

- A desktop, laptop, tablet or ios or android smartphone (a bigger screen is better)
- Check your speakers, microphone and web-cam
- An internet connection – broadband wired or wireless (3G or 4G/LTE)

**A good artist needs a good, clear space to work in!**

- It's best to sit at a clear desk or table with a big flat surface, so pack all your clutter away first.
- Make sure you've got a comfortable chair
- If you can choose a quiet space in your home, that would be great so you don't get distracted!
