It is very important that you discuss your wishes with your family or loved ones to ensure they understand and support your decision to leave a bequest to Asthma and Respiratory Foundation NZ.

What difference will your bequest make?

New Zealand has the highest rates of asthma in the world second only to the UK, with an estimated 600,000 Kiwis suffering from asthma. Respiratory conditions are the leading cause of unplanned hospital admissions for children under five. Every year asthma causes the death of over 100 New Zealanders and over 250,000 people globally.
