

Terms and conditions World Asthma Days Schools competition

1. By entering the prize draw you are agreeing to these prize draw terms and conditions.
2. The prize draw is being run by the Asthma and Respiratory Foundation NZ, Level 2, The Woolstore, 262 Thorndon Quay, Wellington 6011.

Eligibility to enter

3. The prize draw is open to all New Zealand schools.
4. In entering the prize draw, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and eligible to claim any prize you may win.

How to enter

5. The prize draw opens at 12.00am on 8 March 2019 and closes at 12pm on 21 May 2019 Late entries will not be accepted.
6. To enter the prize draw: The school needs to deposit money from their World Asthma Day activities into the Asthma Foundations bank account before 12pm on 21 May 2019.
7. Every \$25 deposited puts the school into the draw to win a scooter.

8. There is a prize limit of one scooter per school.
9. The Foundation will not accept responsibility if contact details provided are incomplete or inaccurate; or for prize draw entries that are lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed in transit.

Winner announcement

16. Winners will be notified after 21 May by phone and/or email.

17. The Foundation will attempt to contact winners by email up to two times. If contact is not made, the Foundation reserves the right to choose and notify a new winner.

Claiming the prize

18. [Please allow 14 days for delivery of the prize] Prizes will only be released following proof of identification.]

19. If a winner does not claim their prize within 14 days, they will lose their right to the prize.

20. If the winner cannot be contacted or has not claimed their prize within the required time limit, the Foundation reserves the right to choose and notify a new winner.

Data protection and publicity

21. You consent to any personal information you provide in entering the prize draw being used by the Foundation for the purposes of administering the prize draw.

22. Winners agree to participate in any reasonable publicity related to the prize draw which may include the publication of their name and photograph in any media.
