VARIETY OVERVIEW

ROCKSTAR[®] is an exceptionally high-yielding, mid-slow spring maturing variety, with a similar time to flowering as LRPB Trojan[®]. It has an Australian Prime Hard (APH) classification in the South Eastern Zone.

ROCKSTAR[®] delivers exceptional yields and provides a large yield improvement within the mid-slow spring maturity class*. ROCKSTAR[®] offers an opportunity to maximise earlier sowing opportunities and spread flowering windows during critical spring stress periods.

ROCKSTAR[®] has good stem rust (MR), yellow leaf spot (MRMS) and stripe rust (MRMS) resistance. It has a good grain size, good test weight and has a moderate plant height, being similar to Mace[®]. ROCKSTAR[®] is an excellent varietal alternative to LRPB Trojan[®], Catapult[®] and Beckom[®].

ROCKSTAR[®] is available for planting from local resellers, Seedclub members and via Farmer to Farmer trade.

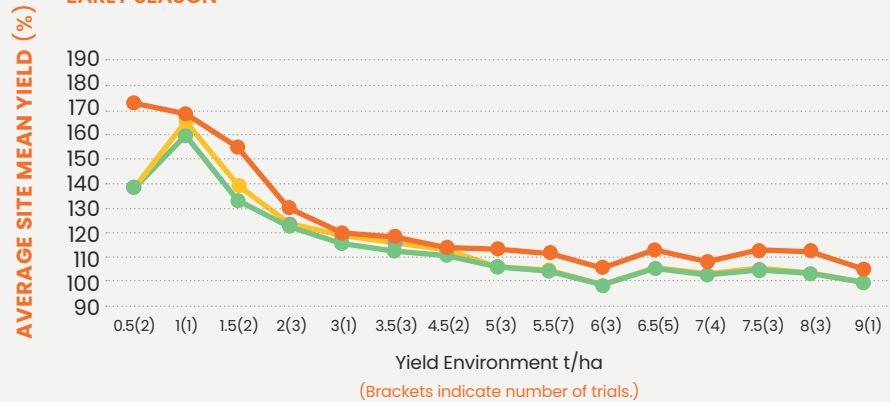

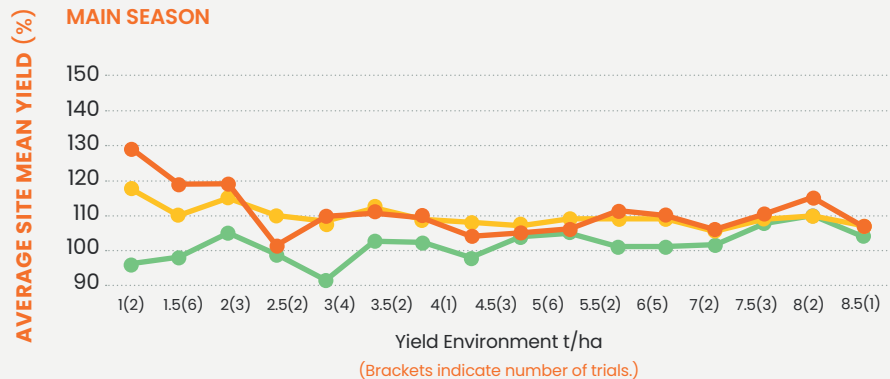


2016–20 Southern NSW early season NVT predicted MET yield performance, represented by yield environment as a % of site mean yield

MAIN SEASON



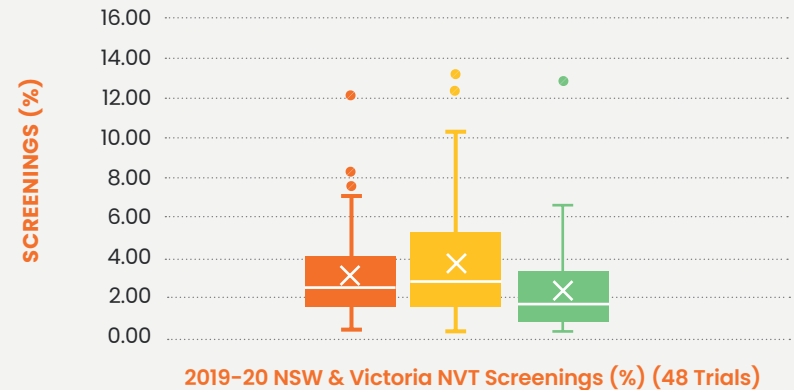
2016–20 Southern NSW main season NVT predicted MET yield performance, represented by yield environment as a % of site mean yield

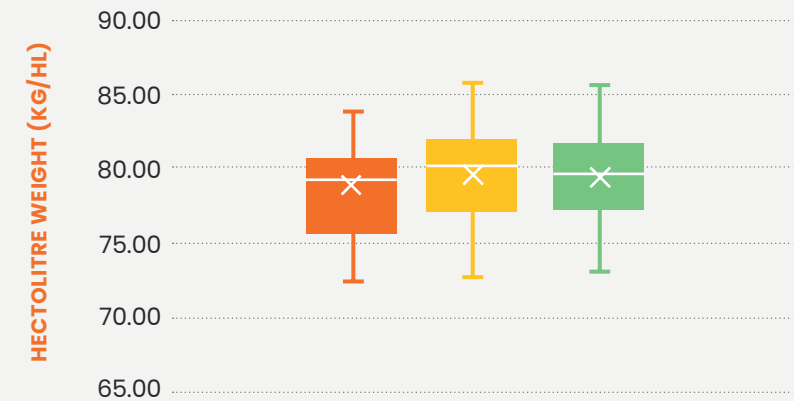


2019–20 NSW & Victoria NVT Screenings (%) (48 Trials)
